

The Science Department at CCSC is one of the leading and largest faculties in the school. We are driven by the desire to ensure every child achieve their full potential. We set very high standards for staff and most pupils achieve aspirational targets set at the beginning of each Key Stage.

The Faculty has five dedicated Science labs with excellent support and facilities. Overall resources are very good; each lab has an interactive whiteboard, access to WiFi and the latest Apple Mac technology including Apple TV and staff iPads.

In line with the school's innovative curriculum the Science Faculty now run a two-year KS3 programme. Students start KS4 in Year 9 and embark on a linear GCSE Science programme (Edexcel). We deliver Triple Science to upper band classes. The number of students at CCSC achieving two grade A*-C GCSE's in Science has vastly improved in recent years. In 2014 99% of Year 11 achieved Core Science, 90% achieved Additional Science and 89% achieved both. These results are truly reflective of the high standard of science teaching and the dedication from teaching staff.
