Show My Homework

I would like to remind parents/carers that they can track all homework set for their children via the Show My Homework website. This will enable parents/ carers to see when homework is set and when it is due in. This is particularly important in the build up the upcoming GCSE examinations.

iPads

May I remind parents that pupil's iPads are for use in school and are not to be taken home. Pupils also risk losing their iPads if they are not looked after in an appropriate manner.

Uniform

Parent Portal
