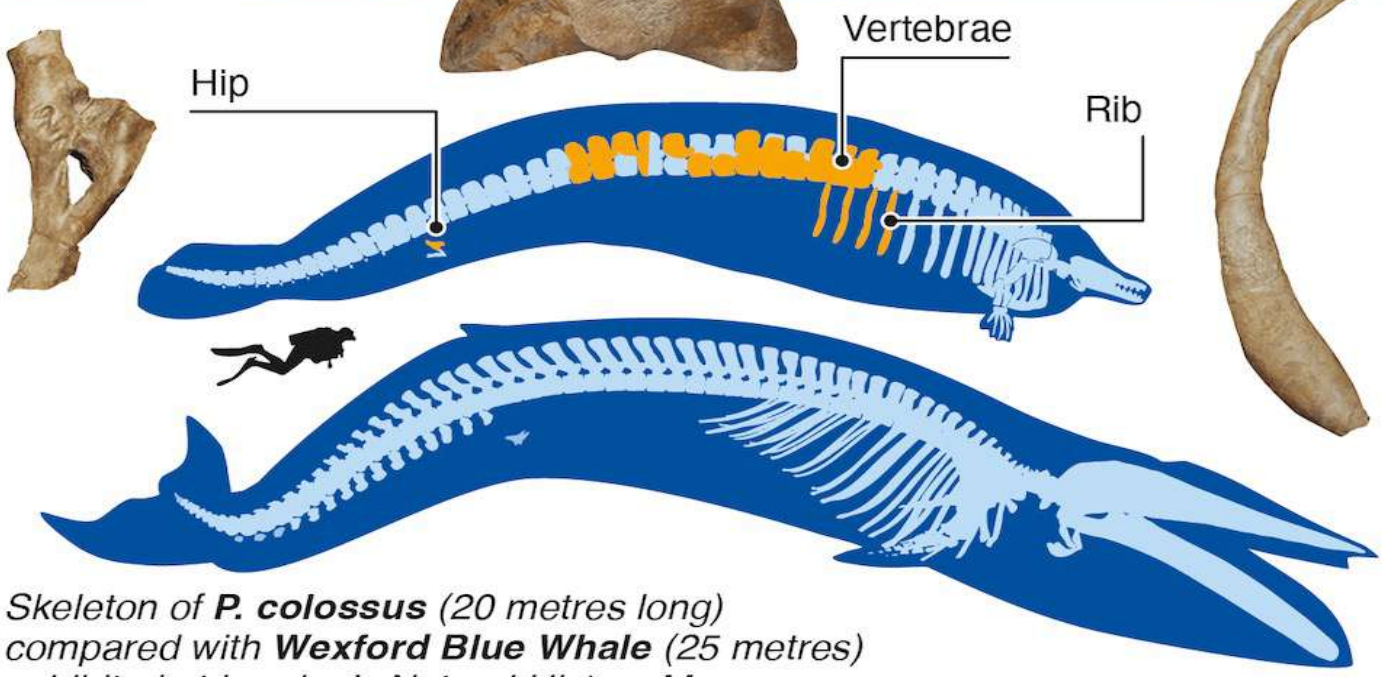
**A newly discovered ancient species of whale is thought to be even heavier than the blue whale, the largest animal ever known to have lived on Earth**



***Perucetus colossus***  
Lived in middle *Eocene* period (39 million years ago)

Partial skeleton – 13 vertebrae, four ribs and hip bone – found in Ica desert

High bone mass indicates *P. colossus* lived in shallow waters



*Skeleton of **P. colossus** (20 metres long) compared with **Wexford Blue Whale** (25 metres) exhibited at London's Natural History Museum*

■ *P. colossus* had skeletal mass 2-3 times that of 25m-long blue whale and body mass of 85-340 tonnes

■ New findings indicate gigantism in marine mammals began 30 million years earlier than previously thought

Press the green button under the Sora logo and select our school from the list.



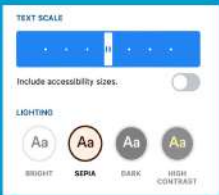
Press the 'explore' tab at the bottom of the screen to show the titles that are available.

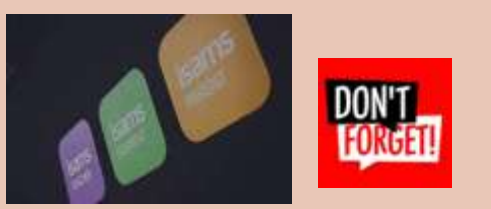
